

DESIGN YOUR OWN MAD HAT COMPETITION

Terms and Conditions

These are The Witham and The Castle Players Terms and Conditions for the Design your own Mad Hat Competition.

1. The competition is open to all residents of the UK, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man except the close relatives of The Witham staff, The Castle Players members, anyone connected with the competition or the particular prize being offered. Permission to enter will be required from a parent or guardian. Proof of permission, identity and eligibility may be required. The Witham reserves the right to disqualify any entrant or winner who breaches these rules.
2. The competition is only open to those aged between 4 and 11 years (inclusive) as of 8 June 2019. Entry is based on The Witham receiving a completed hat design on an A4 piece of paper (with the entrant's name on the back) along with a completed entry form, available at www.thewitham.org.uk and also at 3 Horsemarket, Barnard Castle DL12 8LY.
1. The parent or guardian of entrants must provide their name, telephone number, email address, the name of the child and the child's date of birth. Entrants must be available via the contact information they have provided.
2. The competition opens at 10 am on 22 May 2019 and closes at 4pm on 8 June 2019. Entries received after this date will not be considered.
3. The prize: The winner's hat design will be created by The Castle Players and worn by the Mad Hatter in the upcoming summer production of Alice in Wonderland in the grounds of the Bowes Museum. The winner will also receive covered seating tickets for a family of 4 for the opening night on Wednesday 10 July 2019.
4. The winner will be announced on Saturday 15 June 2019 and will be contacted with details of the tickets and hat design. If we have been unable to contact the winner by noon on 12 June 2019, a runner up will be selected as the winner.
5. The prize is stated as above. There is no cash alternative and the prize cannot be sold or transferred in any circumstances.
6. The first and surname of the winner will be made public.
7. By entering the competition, the entrants warrant that they have legal capacity to enter the competition and agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. As the entrant is under 18 years of age, the parent/guardian of an applicant is deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions when consenting to the entry. The completion of the entry form is also deemed as permission to display the hat design at The Witham.
8. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence relating to the competition will be entered into. Unsuccessful participants will not be contacted.
9. The Witham reserves the right to disqualify any entry, including the winner, which breaches any of these terms and conditions or who acts fraudulently in any way.
10. The Witham reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions in any way.

11. The Witham reserves the right to cancel the competition at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, or if circumstances arise outside its control.
12. The Witham reserves the right to: (i) amend these terms and conditions and vary the competition rules including but not limited to the opening and closing dates; (ii) disqualify any entrant who breaches the rules or has acted fraudulently in any way or; (iii) cancel the competition, at any stage, if in its opinion it is deemed necessary or if circumstances arise outside its control.
13. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales.
